A. Library Operation Updates:

MPC is open w/masks, enrollment is down and they have shorter hours.

HCL is open with filled positions . Enrollment is also down (online classes as well) They will be hiring a new Dean ASAP.

NPS Open, no mask mandate. Reports the library is packed with students, and study spaces are open but Staff is teleworking 4 days a week.

SPL Has no mask mandate but most still wear them, El Gabilan branch to open Saturdays starting April 23.They have a new Tech Services Manager Francis Hebert. Study rooms at EG branch remain very popular.

Carmel is open only 3 days a week, but very busy. No new staff has been hired yet. They need staff to relieve workers doing more jobs within the Library.

MCFL Has been working on adding ADA accessible computers and screen readers. They have hired 2 new people for Carmel Valley and Seaside. They need a Librarian at Buena Vista and King City.

WPL is open all the way, masks are optional, but everyone is wearing them. They are hiring for 5 positions.

MPL Is open 5 days a week: part timers have been moved to half-time, etc.

They need a Bookmobile driver. Their Library Director is retiring. Door count is down, but hours will increase when they can get more staff.

B. Update on Hiatus Request presented to Admin Council: They do NOT want us to take a hiatus, they fear losing communication with the Tech Committee. However, we can set our meetings 3 months apart, changing that at any time with a vote. We can also cancel if needed. Chair terms can also be changed any time by vote.
